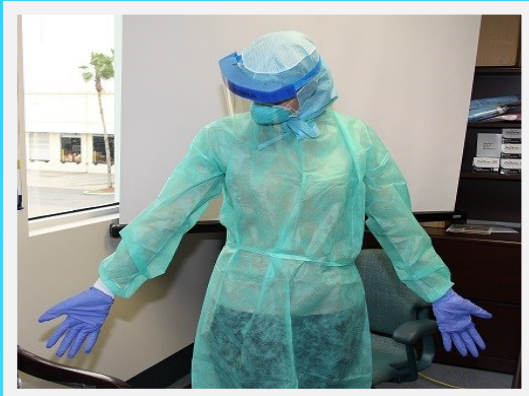


The Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County
