


Other includes American Indian/Alaska Native, Asian/Pacific Islander, and multi-racial.

The HIV Care Continuum reflects stages of HIV medical care that begin with an initial diagnosis and aim to achieve a very low level of HIV in the body (viral suppression). A person living with HIV (PLWH) with a suppressed viral load has a less than 1% chance of transmitting the virus.
