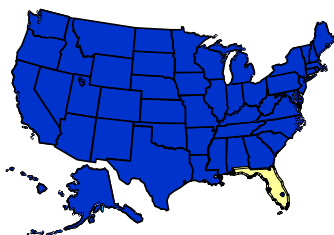


## 2005

### FLORIDA

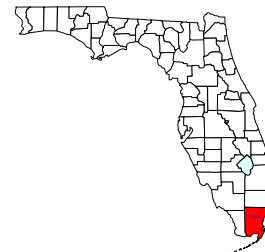
- ⚡ Cumulatively through 2005, **101,013** (99,509 adult) AIDS cases have been reported in Florida. Florida ranks **third** in the nation in the number of AIDS cases.
- ⚡ In 2005, 4,869 AIDS cases were reported in Florida.
- ⚡ Cumulatively through 2005, **1,504** pediatric AIDS cases have been reported in Florida. Florida ranks **second** in the nation in the number of pediatric AIDS cases.
- ⚡ Males account for **76%** of cumulative reported AIDS cases, and females account for **24%**. The male-to-female ratio is **3.1:1**.
- ⚡ Of the cumulative number of AIDS cases, **49%** are among blacks, **35%** are among whites, and **16%** are among Hispanics.
- ⚡ Cumulatively through 2005, **35,584** HIV (not AIDS) cases have been reported, which includes **370** pediatric HIV (not AIDS) cases. (Reporting of HIV was implemented on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 1997)
- ⚡ In 2005, **5,621** HIV (regardless of AIDS status) cases were reported in Florida.
- ⚡ Males account for **65%** of cumulative reported HIV (not AIDS) cases, and females account for **56%**. The male-to-female ratio is **1.8:1**.
- ⚡ Of the cumulative number of HIV (not AIDS) cases, **53%** are among blacks, **28%** are among whites, and **18%** are among Hispanics.
- ⚡ In 2005, there were **286,258** HIV tests performed by county public health departments, with **1.8%** of the tests being positive.
- ⚡ An estimated 125,000 persons, or roughly 11.7% of the national estimate of 1,185,000, are currently through to be HIV-infected in Florida.

### MIAMI-DADE

- ⚡ Cumulatively through 2005, **29,135** cases have been reported in Miami-Dade County. Miami-Dade County ranks **first** in the state in the number of AIDS cases.
- ⚡ In 2005, **1,249** AIDS cases were reported in Miami-Dade County.
- ⚡ Cumulatively through 2005, **498** pediatric AIDS cases have been reported in Miami-Dade County. Miami-Dade County ranks **first** in the state in the number of pediatric AIDS cases.
- ⚡ Males account for **75%** of cumulative reported AIDS cases, and females account for **25%**. The male-to-female ratio is **3:1**.
- ⚡ Of the cumulative number of AIDS cases, **52%** are among blacks, **15%** are among whites, and **33%** are among Hispanics.
- ⚡ Cumulatively through 2005, **10,486** HIV (not AIDS) cases have been reported, which includes **124** pediatric HIV cases. (Reporting of HIV was implemented on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 1997)
- ⚡ In 2005, **1,395** HIV (regardless of AIDS status) cases were reported in Miami-Dade County.
- ⚡ Males account for **68%** of cumulative reported HIV cases, and females account for **32%**. The male-to-female ratio is **2.1:1**.
- ⚡ Of the cumulative number of HIV (not AIDS) cases, **51%** are among Blacks, **14%** are among Whites, and **34%** are among Hispanics.
- ⚡ In 2005, there were **39,139** HIV tests performed in Miami-Dade County, with **3.3%** of the tests being positive.
- ⚡ An estimate 23,159 persons, or roughly 19% of the state total, are currently living with HIV infection in Miami-Dade County.
