

## HIV/AIDS AMONG HISPANICS IN FLORIDA AND MIAMI-DADE





## **FLORIDA**

- Hispanics comprise 20% of Florida's adult (13+) population, but 17% of the 3,888 adult AIDS cases and 21% of the 6,071 HIV (not AIDS) cases reported in 2007.
- In 2007, Hispanics accounted for 20% of AIDS cases in men and 11% of those in women. Hispanic al also accounted for 24% of HIV cases in men and 15% of those in women.
- In 2007, the reported AIDS cases rate and HIV (regardless of AIDS status) cases rate among Hispanics men were 33.9 and 66.5 per 100,000 population, respectively. Both rates were more than twice the rate among white males
- In 2007, the reported AIDS cases rate and HIV (regardless of AIDS status) cases rate among Hispanics women were 9.2 and 17.1 per 100,000 population, respectively. Hispanic women were nearly three times as likely as white women to be reported with HIV
- HIV cases diagnosed among Hispanics between 2000 and 2007 increased by 40%. New HIV cases among Hispanic males increased by 43%; however new HIV cases among Hispanic females decreased by 24%.
- Cumulatively through 2007, 230 (11%) of Florida's 2,254 pediatric HIV/AIDS cases were Hispanic.
- Among living Hispanic male HIV/AIDS cases reported through 2007, men who have sex with men was the leading mode of exposure with 71% of cases; followed by 14% with heterosexual contact and 10% IDU.
- 85% of all living Hispanic females HIV/AIDS cases reported through 2007 were infected through heterosexual contact, 14% were attributed IDU.

## MIAMI~DADE

- Hispanics comprise 62% of Miami-Dade population, but 33% of the 31,038 AIDS cases and 36% of the 11,650 HIV (not AIDS) cases reported through December 2007.
- In 2007, Hispanics accounted for 40.9% of AIDS cases in men and 18.9% of those in women.
- In 2007, Hispanics accounted for 48.2% of HIV (regardless of AIDS status) cases in men and 21.1% of those in women.
- In 2007, the reported AIDS cases rate and HIV (regardless of AIDS status) cases rate among Hispanics men were 30.4 and 69.2 per 100,000 population, respectively. Both rates were lower than the rate among white males.
- In 2007, the rate of HIV (regardless of AIDS status) for adult Hispanic female was 10.3 and 6.7for AIDS. Hispanics women were slightly lower than white women to be reported with HIV
- HIV cases diagnosed among Hispanics between 2000 and 2007 increase by 13.7%. New HIV cases among Hispanic males increase by 17.7% and among Hispanic females by 5.7%.
- Cumulatively, 51 (10%) of Miami-Dade's pediatric AIDS and 28 (15.8%) pediatric HIV (not AIDS) cases are Hispanic.
- Among living Hispanic male HIV/AIDS cases reported through 2007, men who have sex with men was the leading mode of exposure with 69.6% of cases; 9.8% were attributes to heterosexual contact and 5.1% to IDU.
- 72.4% of all living Hispanic females HIV/AIDS cases reported through 2007 were infected through heterosexual contact, 8.9% were attributed IDU.
