

HIV/AIDS IN FLORIDA AND MIAMI~DADE COUNTY



2008

FLORIDA

- X Cumulatively through 2008, 114,057 AIDS cases have been reported in Florida. Florida ranks third in the nation in the number of AIDS cases and third in the rate per 100,000 AIDS cases.
- In 2008, 4,944 AIDS cases were reported in Florida.
- **%** Cumulatively through 2008, **1,536** pediatric AIDS cases have been reported in Florida. Florida ranks **second** in the nation in the number of pediatric AIDS cases.
- Males account for **69%** of cumulative reported AIDS cases, and females account for **31%**. The male-to-female ratio is **2.2:1**.
- Cumulatively through 2008, 43,814 HIV (not AIDS) cases have been reported, which includes 609 pediatric HIV (not AIDS) cases. (Reporting of HIV was implemented on July 1st, 1997)
- In 2008, **7,498** HIV (regardless of AIDS status) cases were reported in Florida.
- Males account for 74% of cumulative reported HIV (not AIDS) cases, and females account for 26%. The male-to-female ratio is 2.8:1.
- Of the AIDS cases reported in 2008, 27% were among whites, 15% were among blacks, 20% were among Hispanic and 2% were among other races.
- 8 Of the HIV cases reported in 2008, 34% were among whites, 46% were among blacks, 19% were among Hispanic and 1% were among other races.
- In 2008, there were 325,393 HIV tests performed by county public health departments, with 1.6% of the tests being positive.
- An estimated 125,000 persons, or roughly 11.7% of the national estimate of 1,185,000, are currently through to be HIV-infected in Florida.



MIAMI~DADE

- Cumulatively through 2008, 32,141 AIDS cases have been reported in Miami-Dade. Miami-Dade ranks first in the state in the number of AIDS cases and fourth in the rate per 100,000 AIDS cases among metropolitan statistical area.
- In 2008, 1,141 AIDS cases were reported in Miami-Dade.
- X Cumulatively through 2008, 510 pediatric AIDS cases have been reported in Miami-Dade. Miami-Dade ranks first in the state in the number of pediatric AIDS cases.
- Males account for 74% of cumulative reported AIDS cases, and females account for 26%. The male-to-female ratio is 2.9:1.
- Cumulatively through 2008, 12,297 HIV (not AIDS) cases have been reported, which includes 177 pediatric HIV (not AIDS) cases. (Reporting of HIV was implemented on July 1st, 1997)
- In 2008, **1549** HIV (regardless of AIDS status) cases were reported in Miami-Dade.
- Males account for 70% of cumulative reported HIV (not AIDS) cases, and females account for 30%. The male-to-female ratio is 2.3:1.
- X Of the AIDS cases reported in 2008, 10% were among whites, 53% were among blacks, 35% were among Hispanic and 1% were among other races.
- 8 Of the HIV cases reported in 2008, 14% were among whites, 45% were among blacks, 41% were among Hispanic and 1% were among other races.
- In 2008, there were **59,439** HIV tests performed by county public health departments, with **2.7%** of the tests being positive.
- An estimated **25,099** persons, or roughly **20%** of the state estimate of 125,000, are currently through to be HIV-infected in Miami-Dade.
