

HIV/AIDS AMONG HAITIANS





In FLORIDA *

- ✓ Florida's population consist of 182,224 foreign born Haitians or 1.1% of Florida's population. (US Census 2000)
- ✓ In Florida, the Haitian~born population accounted for approximately 1% of the black living HIV/AIDS cases reported through December 2008.
- ✓ The majority of the living Haitian-born HIV/AIDS cases are ages 40+. Among males 83% were ages 40+ and 70% of females were ages 40+.
- ✓ Twenty three percent of Florida's 6,647 living Haitian-born HIV/AIDS cases were reported from Miami-Dade County, 21% from Broward County and 29% from Palm Beach County.
- ✓ Among males, heterosexual contact is the major mode of transmission for living Haitian-born male cases (62%), followed be men having sex with men [MSM] (31%) and injection drug use [IDU] (5%).
- ✓ Among females, heterosexual contact is the major mode of transmission for living Haitian-born female cases (96%) and IDU (2%).

In MIAMI-DADE

- ✓ In Miami-Dade County Haitian-born represents 3% of the county's population according to US Census 2000.
- ✓ In Miami-Dade, the Haitian-born population accounted for approximately 21% of the black living HIV/AIDS cases reported through December 2008.
- ✓ The majority of the living Haitian-born HIV/AIDS cases are ages 30+. Among males 87% were ages 30+ and 78% of females were ages 30+.
- Forty eight percent of Miami-Dade's 2,682 living Haitian-born HIV/AIDS cases were reported from Liberty City, 16% from Opa-Locka, Carol City and vicinity, and 15% from Little Haiti and vicinity.
- Among males, heterosexual contact is the major mode of transmission for living Haitian-born male cases (54%), followed be men having sex with men [MSM] (37%) and injection drug use [IDU] (7%).
- ✓ Among females, heterosexual contact is the major mode of transmission for living Haitian-born female cases (94%) and IDU (5%).
