

# HIV/AIDS AMONG SENIORS IN FLORIDA AND MIAMI-DADE 2008

## FLORIDA

⚡ In 2008, those aged 50+ made up 25% of AIDS cases and 19% of HIV cases reported in Florida.

⚡ Through 2008, persons at the current age 50+ accounted for 27% of all people living with HIV/AIDS in Florida.

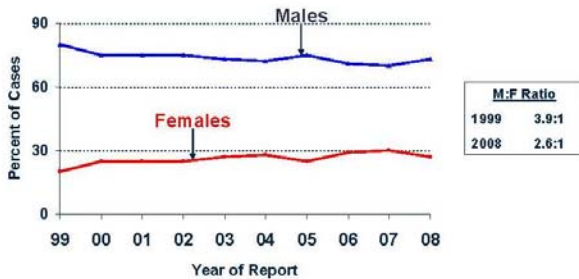
⚡ Of the 28,386 living HIV/AIDS cases reported among persons aged 50 and older in Florida through 2008, they represent the following percentages:

Male	74%
Female	26%
White	32%
Black	50%
Hispanic	18%

⚡ Blood transfusion, once a common mode of transmission in this age group, has significantly declined over time. Currently, less than 1% of the reported cases among both men and women have a blood or other related risk.

⚡ The gap in the number of reported AIDS cases among males and females aged 50+ has steadily decreased over time. In 1999, the male to female ratio was 3.9:1 compared to 2.6:1 in 2008.



⚡ Of all the living HIV/AIDS cases in Florida among persons aged 50 and older reported through 2008, 57% were diagnoses from the following three counties :

- Miami-Dade 29%
- Broward 17%
- Palm Beach 9%

⚡ Of the 2,504 HIV/AIDS cases death in 2006, 41% were among people 50 years old and over.

## MIAMI-DADE

⚡ In 2008, those aged 50+ made up 30% of AIDS cases and 21% of HIV cases reported in Miami-Dade.

⚡ Through 2008, persons at the current age 50+ accounted for 14% of all people living with HIV/AIDS in Miami-Dade.

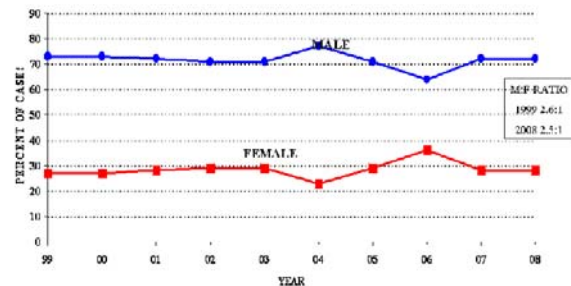
⚡ Of the 3,573 living HIV/AIDS cases reported among persons aged 50 and older in Miami-Dade through 2008, they represent the following percentages:

Male	71%
Female	29%
White	11%
Black	53%
Hispanic	34%

⚡ Blood transfusion, once a common mode of transmission in this age group, has significantly declined over time. Currently, less than 1% of the reported cases among both men and women have a blood or other related risk.

MSM	53%	
IDU	10%	9%
MSM/IDU	4%	
HETERO	33%	91%
OTHER	<1%	<1%

⚡ The gap in the number of reported AIDS cases among males and females aged 50+ has stay the same over time. In 1999, the male to female ratio was 2.6:1 compared to 2.5:1 in 2008.



⚡ Of all the living HIV/AIDS cases in Miami-Dade among persons aged 50 and older reported through 2008, 50% were diagnoses from the following three areas :

- Liberty City & vicinity 21%
- Little Haiti, Brownville & vicinity 15%
- Little Havana, Overtown & vicinity 14%

⚡ Of the 397 cases of HIV related death in 2007 in Miami-Dade, 63% were among people aged 45 years old and over.
