Many people have no signs or symptoms of STDs and/or they may not recognize them. Untreated STDs can lead to serious health problems. Syphilis, like many other STDs, facilitates the spread of HIV by increasing the likelihood of transmission.

Theme is "TALK, TEST, TREAT!"

- April 1-9 | An overview of this year's theme and how preventing STDs can be simple with these three actions:
Talk.Test.Treat.
- April 10-16 | TALK: Talk openly to partners, patients, and healthcare providers about sexual health and STDs.
- April 17-23 | TEST: Ensure everyone knows who should be tested and when.
- April 24-30 | TREAT: The important role healthcare providers *and* patients play in making sure STDs are treated correctly.

Florida 2015

Over 100,000 cases of Chlamydia, Gonorrhea and Syphilis

1 case of an STD was diagnosed every 20 minutes in teens between the ages of 15–19

1 case of an STD was diagnosed every 12 minutes in young adults between the ages of 20–24

7 cases of an STD was diagnosed every day in a pregnant woman

19 cases of an STD was diagnosed every day in MSM

Over the past 5 years in Florida, MSM have most of the early syphilis and HIV co-infections

Miami-Dade County 2015

First in STD Cases in Florida

9 cases of an STD was diagnosed every day in teens between the ages of 15–19

15 cases of an STD was diagnosed every day in young adults between the ages of 20–24

5 STDs are diagnosed in MSM every day

Statistics are provided from the Department of Health Division of Disease Control and Health Protection Bureau of Communicable Diseases/STD section

Zika can also be transmitted Sexually.
