

DOH-Miami-Dade opens limited number of COVID-19 vaccine appointments

Miami, FL – The Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County opens a limited number of COVID-19 vaccine appointments for seniors ages 65 and older **by appointment only**.

The appointments will be available today starting at 4 pm Friday, January 8 through a scheduling tool in partnership with Miami-Dade County at miamidade.gov/vaccine. The website is also available in Spanish at miamidade.gov/vaccine and in Haitian Creole at miamidade.gov/vaksen.

Demand for vaccines is currently much greater than existing supply. Appointments will close once the availability of vaccines have been depleted and will reopen once additional vaccines are received. Please continue to check <u>miamidade.gov/vaccine</u> for updates.

The vaccine being offered requires a second dose. At the time of vaccination, individuals will receive information regarding the second dose. After receiving the vaccine, individuals will be required to remain seated for 15-30 minutes for medical monitoring.
