and

and

North Shore Ocean Terrace 73<sup>rd</sup> Street Miami Beach, FL 33141

Tests completed on Tuesday, March 19, 2024, indicate that the water quality at Surfside Beach – 93<sup>rd</sup> Street, Haulover Beach South and North Shore Ocean Terrace show an acceptable level of *Enterococcus* bacteria established by state guidelines.
