**Miami, Fla. —** The Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County (DOH-Miami-Dade) is lifting the advisory for high bacterial levels for the following locations:

***Surfside Beach - 93<sup>rd</sup> St., Surfside, FL 33154***

***Collins Park - 21<sup>st</sup> St., Miami Beach, FL 33140***

Tests completed on Wednesday July 4, 2024, indicate that the water quality at Surfside Beach – 93<sup>rd</sup> Street and Collins Park - 21<sup>st</sup> St. show an acceptable level of *Enterococcus* bacteria established by state guidelines.
