Program, located at the
Florida Department of Health in
Miami-Dade County, provides a
free health assessment and
immunizations for all eligible adult
and child refugees.

To be eligible for health services, you must provide documentation such as an I–94 card/form, all immigration documents, passport, or official photo identification.

Health service appointments are provided based upon the program's current guidelines and availability.

Contact the Florida Department of Health in Miami-Dade County within 30 days of arrival into the United States for an eligibility determination appointment. This can help to ensure your health assessment is completed within 90 days of arrival to the U.S.

If you are applying for Adjustment of Status to Lawful Permanent Resident, you are required to have up-to-date immunizations.
